## **1. PURPOSE AND IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1.1.** The Mysore Paper Mills Limited Bhadravati-577 302 invites tenders from eligible tenderers for the works detailed under the SECTION – SPECIFICATION by considering the all terms and conditions covered in this tender document.
- 1.2 The tenderers may submit tenders for all of the works given above. Tenderers are advised to note the qualification criteria specified in clauses to qualify for award of the contract
- 1.3 Tender documents (and additional copies) may be purchased from the office of Manager (I.E), Mysore Paper Mills Limited, Bhadravathi-577302 Karnataka from **01-03-2016 to 07-03-2016**, up to 12.00 hours, on payment of Rs. 500/- in person or by post (Non refundable/nor transferable) drawn in favour of "The Mysore Paper mills Ltd.," at any Nationalized / Schedule bank payable at Bhadravathi, Karnataka State for any postal delay either for non delivery of the document or non-receipt of the same MPM will not be responsible. - 1.4. Tenders must be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of the amount specified in the tender document, drawn in favour of The Mysore Paper Mills Limited, Bhadravati-577 302 EMD will have to be in any one of the forms as specified in the Tender document and shall have to be valid for 30 days beyond the validity of the tender.
- 1.5. Tenders must be delivered to The Office of Manager(I.E), The Mysore Paper Mills Limited Bhadravati-577 302 on or before 14.00 hours on **07-03-2016** in single sealed cover for the work of Strengthening of CFBC coal fired boiler ESP inlet and outlet duct nozzles and flue gas Ducting and will be opened on the same day at 15.00 hours, in the presence of the tenderers or their authorized representatives who wish to attend. If the office happens to be closed on the date of receipt of the tenders as specified, the tenders will be received and opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.

## **2. SCOPE OF WORK :**

- 2.1. Replacing old MS sheet with new MS sheet for flue gas duct of size 2.25 mtrs. x 12 mtrs. from economizer to inlet of ID fan, ESP top and inlet/outlet nozzle of ESP.
- 2.2. Providing stiffeners wherever required. This includes fixing of expansion bellow –
- 2.3. 25mtrs. x 2.25 mtr.
- 2.4. Applying one coat of red oxide paint.
- 2.5. Carrying out insulation of the ducting wherever the same is damaged or removed for carrying out the replacement.
- 2.6. Job content is estimated as 6 MT.

## **3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

- 3.1. Contractor is inspect the site and obtain all required clarifications from Sr. Mgr. (Boilers)i/c before quoting for the job.
- 3.2. Required welding sets, tools and tackles are to be mobilized by contractor for carrying out the job.
- 3.3. Required materials are to be brought from stores, steel yard, workshop and etc. after completion of works scarp is to be disposed to scrap yard.
- 3.4. Prevailing safety practices are to be followed while carrying out the job.
- 3.5. Job to be completed with 20 days.
- 3.6. Prices to be quoted on per MT basis.
- 3.7. Validity of the offer is to be for six months.

## **4. MPM SCOPE:**

Materials required for such as steel items, paint and insulation materials, welding electrodes and oxygen and acetylene gas.

## **6. TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

100% Payment After completion of above said work, and with certification by the bill certifying authority.

## **7. QUANTITY :**

Quantity is mentioned in the Price Format. However the quantities should not be made a point of dispute by the Tenderer. MPM will not entertain any Claims from the Successful Tenderer if there is a reduction / increase in the quantum of Work

**8. SUBMISSION OF TENDER:**

Tenderers should submit tenders in a single sealed cover by registered post / courier or in person containing the Technical / Pre-qualification Bid covering all Technical and Pre-qualification aspects along with EMD and Price Bid in the prescribed format enclosed.

The tender documents complete in all respects shall be submitted in a single sealed cover indicating Technical / Pre-qualification Bid and Price Bid. The cover to be duly super scribed with the Tender No. and due date and From address so as to reach the Manager (IE) , Industrial Engineering Department, The Mysore Paper Mills Ltd., Paper Town, Bhadravati – 577302, Shimoga Dist., Karnataka on or before **07-03-2016 within 14 hrs.**

Late Offers are liable for rejection, Telex / Telegraphic quotations will not be considered. The Tender is liable to be rejected if incomplete information is given thereon or if the particulars and data asked for in the Tender are not fully complied with or if the Documents submitted are improper.

**9. EMD, VALIDITY OF THE OFFER AND OTHER DETAILS:**

- 9.1 Tenderer must remit along with their offer an Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 4,600/- The EMD should be paid by way of Bank Demand Draft (OR Bank Guarantee in the prescribed Format) favouring The Mysore Paper Mills Ltd., Bhadravati – 577 302 drawn on any scheduled Banks having Branch office at Bhadravati in Karnataka State (and not on Ordnance Factory, Bhadravati of Maharashtra State).
- 9.2 The EMD paid through DD will be returned by way of a Cheque to the unsuccessful Tenderer after finalization of the Tender. The EMD amount will not attract any interest.
- 9.3 The EMD paid through DD by the Successful Tenderer will be returned by way of a Cheque in case he submits a Bank Guarantee for the prescribed amount towards Security Deposit covering the period of one year and three months otherwise, the EMD amount will be converted as Security Deposit.
- 9.4 Incase the Bidder backs out in between from the Tender during processing of award of the Contract his EMD is liable for forfeiture.

**10. WORK COMPLETION PERIOD:**

Work to be completed within 10 Days from the date of receiving the work order.

**11. WORK EXECUTION LOCATION:** At MPM site CFBC Boiler area**12. VALIDITY :** 12 months from the issue of work order**13. TRANSPORTATION:**

To and Fro Transportation of vehicles and manpower required to carryout the work detailed above is in the scope of the tenderer.

**14. TAXES AND DUTIES:**

Taxes / Duties liability other than the Service Tax if any shall be to Tenderer's Account.

**15. INSPECTION:** Inspection by MPM officials at MPM site

**16. GROUP INSURANCE, ESI AND PF:**

16.1 Tenderer will be responsible and be required to obtain Workers Compensation Linked Group Insurance Policy against Accidental Risk, Injuries partial or otherwise disabilities and death while on duty for his Workers / Supervisors or any type of workmen engaged by the Tenderer during the Contract Validity Period. The expenditure of Insurance Premium will be borne by the Tenderer.

16.2 Tenderer must have Employee State Insurance (ESI) code and Provident Fund (PF) code of their company and remit the ESI and PF contributions of their workers under that code. If the Tenderer do not posses these codes, in the event of issuing work order on the successful Tenderer, they shall furnish the same within one month from the date of issue of work order. In this effect the Tenderer shall furnish an undertaking on a Rs. 200 bond paper. If the Tenderer fails to furnish these codes then MPM reserves the right to cancel the work order. Besides payments will be withheld till such codes are provided. In this regard MPM's decision is final.

**17. PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT:**

The agency should have carried out similar works during the past 3 years

**18. SERVICE TAX**

With regards to Service Tax, as per the Finance Bill for 2015-16 new service tax structure is effecting from 01-06-2015, as per this MPM is responsible only for the portion of service tax to be paid by MPM. For the service tax to be paid by the agency, it is the sole responsibility of them to pay the service tax. As per Finance bill/ rules/ regulations, if at all MPM has to reimburse the service tax to the agency, same will be done as per the discretion of the Finance department of MPM. So, it is advised that agency to be familiar with the service tax structure, payment, reimbursement etc.,

**19. STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS:**

Tenderer shall comply with any and all the laws, ordinances, regulations and decisions of Courts (which shall be deemed to be a part of this agreement) and shall exclusively bear the consequences for failure to comply therewith. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Tenderer shall fully comply with the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, the worker (Regulation and Abolition) Act, Workmen's Compensation Act, Employee State Insurance (ESI) Act, Provident Fund (PF) Act, Profession Tax Act and other Labour Laws and the Rules framed there under

**20. RIGHT OF FORECLOSURE:**

MPM reserves the right to foreclose the Work Order at any time without assigning any reason. The transaction will be closed by settling the accounts up to the date of foreclosure of the Order and no extra claims shall be entertained by MPM for such closure of the Order.

**21. FORCE MAJEURE:**

Neither Party shall be held responsible for any Losses, if the fulfillment of any Terms or Provisions of the Work Order / Contract are delayed or prevented by Acts of Lawful Government Revolutions or other Disorders, Wars, Acts of Enemies, Strikes, Fires, Floods, Acts of God or Acts of States without limiting the foregoing, any other causes not within the control of the Party whose performance is interfered with and which by the exercise of reasonable delinquency, is unable to prevent whether all the clause of causes herein before enumerated or not. The Party claiming occurrence of any event under force majeure shall give Notice within Fifteen Days to the other in writing in the event of instance of any force majeure circumstances, failing which, the supplier shall not be entitled to any benefits under this Clause.

**22. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:**

In the event of any Controversy, Claim, Question or Dispute arising between the Tenderer and the Owner on any matter, relating to the Contract or arising out of the breach thereof the Parties thereto shall use their best efforts to settle such Question, Dispute or difference amicably by mutual negotiations / mediation. In case mediation fails to resolve the Dispute, the matter to be taken up in Civil Courts of Law. The Legal Jurisdiction will be Bangalore in Karnataka State only. Any dispute or difference or claim arising out of, or in connection with, or relating to the present contract or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof, shall be referred and settled under the Arbitration Centre Karnataka (Domestic international) Rules 2012 , by one or more arbitrators appointed in accordance with its rules.

**23. PENALTIES:**

In case the Tenderer fails to execute the Work as per the Terms and Conditions and Instructions of the Reporting Authority, the Management reserves the Right to levy Penalty as mentioned below.

In case the Tenderer abandons/ discontinue the Contract within the validity of the Contract period the MPM management has the right to get the same work done by any other Agency and the Loss or extra expenditure suffered in such event shall be debited to the Tenderers Account in addition to forfeiting the Security Deposit.

Un-satisfactory Performance of the Contract may also lead to black listing of the Tenderer.

**24. BILL CERTIFYING/ COUNTER SIGNING AUTHORITY:**
